Lucky 13 Tattoo uses only brand new tattooing needles for every tattoo. Not only are our needles *new*, they are sterilized in our on-site autoclave. Used needles are shipped to an approved medical waste disposal facility. Stainless steel tubes used in the tattooing process are scrubbed after each tattoo, thoroughly cleaned utilizing high-energy sound waves, and only then are they “hospital sterilized” in our autoclave. Even our autoclave is tested monthly by an independent laboratory for proper and complete sterilization process. Feel free to ask to see our cleaning and sterilization area.

Phil Webber spent over a year as an apprentice learning the craft of tattooing. Only after proving himself proficient in sanitation, sterilization, infection control procedures, tattoo theory, machine setup and maintenance, stenciling and actual tattooing was he able to rise to the rank of “Tattooist”. In early 1999 Phil was issued license number “56” by the State of Vermont.

The State of Vermont wants you to know that the following practices are considered unprofessional conduct for tattooist: (26 V.S.A. 4108 and 3 V.S. A. 129A).

- (1) Using dishonest or misleading advertising.
- (2) Addiction to narcotics, habitual drunkenness or rendering professional services to a client, if the tattooist is intoxicated or under the influence of drugs.
- (3) Sexual harassment of a client.
- (4) Tattooing a minor in violation of the provisions of section 4102 of the State of Vermont Statutes Annotated, Title 26. If you believe any tattooist has violated these rules, or wish to make a consumer inquiry regarding tattooists, please contact:
